A few important notes:

- Materials pickup/drop off – **The procedures for the Monday pickup and drop off have changed.**
  - Beginning Monday, August 10, 2020, parents will enter the parking lot and park between the hours of 7:30 – 9:30 a.m.
  - Tables will be setup along the wall near the office.
  - There will be a bin with hanging files labeled by teacher. Each bin will have a file with your child's name on it. It is within this file that you will pick up classwork and/or drop off completed work and materials.
  - Student supplies and last year's yearbook will be distributed by our PTA members. Date to be determined.

As we proceed with the distance-learning model through the first quarter, we ask that you remain patient through this process. We will continue to evaluate recommendations given by the Arizona Department of Health Services with a goal of opening in-person at the beginning of the second quarter.
